Auckland Electricity Poll - January 2015

Client:	Entrust. At the time of the poll, Entrust was known as the Auckland Energy Consumer Trust (AECT).
Poll Dates:	Thursday 29th January 2015.
Target Population:	Adults in Auckland who pay the power bill.
Sample Population:	Adults in Auckland who pay the power bill who are contactable on a landline.
Sample Size:	500 respondents agreed to participate.
Sample Selection:	A random selection of 10,000 Auckland phone numbers.
Weighting:	The results are weighted to reflect the overall adult population in terms of gender, age and household income.
Sample Error:	Based on this sample of 500 respondents, the maximum sampling error (for a result of 50%) is +/- 4.4%, at the 95% confidence level.
Code Compliance:	This poll was conducted in accordance with the New Zealand Political Polling Code, the Research Association New Zealand Code of Practice and the International Chamber of Commerce/ European Society for Opinion and Market Research Code on Market and Social Research.

The AECT is a major shareholder in the electricity lines company Vector. Each year, it distributes a divided from Vector's profits to Auckland residents in the Trust's area. That dividend was \$335 in 2014. Some people have proposed that the Trust be wound up, and that Auckland Council be given ownership of its shares in Vector to held fund Council projects. What is your preference?

- The AECT remains in place, using profits from Vector to provide dividends to local households in the Trust's area.
- The shareholding of Vector be transferred to Auckland Council, so they can use the profits to fund Council projects.
